Sealed proposals for the **SOUTH WATER TREATMENT PLANT** for The Utilities Board of the City of Foley, Alabama d/b/a. Riviera Utilities, will be received by the Board at the office of same at 413 East Laurel Avenue, Foley, Alabama office until **2:00 p.m., on Tuesday, September 17, 2024** at which time and place proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud.

A pre-bid conference for the Project will be held on **Wednesday**, **August 28**, **2024 at 10:30 a.m.** at the office of Riviera Utilities located at 413 East Laurel Avenue, Foley, Alabama. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is encouraged but not required.

Contract Documents will be available for inspection at the office of The Utilities Board of The City of Foley, located at 413 East Laurel Avenue, Foley, Alabama 36535.

The Issuing Office for the Bidding Documents is Goodwyn Mills Cawood LLC, 11 N. Water St., Suite 15250, Mobile, AL 36602, <u>ashley.morris@gmcnetwork.com</u>. Prospective Bidders may examine the Bidding Documents at the Issuing Office on Mondays through Fridays between the hours of 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., and may obtain copies of the Bidding Documents from the Issuing Office as described below. Printed copies of the Bidding Documents may be obtained from the Issuing Office, during the hours indicated above, upon payment of a deposit of \$20.00 for a one-time administrative fee for digital access/file sharing and/or \$300.00 for each set. Said cost represents the cost of printing, reproduction, handling, and distribution, therefore no refund will be granted. Checks for Bidding Documents shall be payable to "GMC". Partial sets of Bidding Documents will not be available from the Issuing Office. Neither Owner nor Engineer will be responsible for full or partial sets of Bidding Documents, including Addenda if any, obtained from sources other than the Issuing Office.

The work consists principally of the following:

- 1. Construction of a new 5 MGD water treatment plant with chemical treatment, a ~500,000-gallon clearwell, a high service pump, and a new lab and office building.
- 2. New water production well on-site with associated piping, valving and pumping.
- 3. Also includes piping and valves, electrical & SCADA and site work.

As a proposal guaranty, a BID BOND or CERTIFIED CHECK must accompany PROPOSALS in an amount equal to five (5) percent of the proposal or \$50,000, whichever is less. The successful Bidder will be required to furnish a performance bond and a bond for payment for labor and materials in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price or each work order listing, said bonds to remain in full force and effect for a period of one (1) year after the completed Work has been accepted by the owner.

All bidders must comply with the Contractor's Licensing Laws of the State of Alabama (Ala. Code 1975, Title 34, Chapter 8), and must be certified for the type of work involved. It is also noted that any subcontractor performing Work in excess of \$50,000.00 must also be licensed as a general contractor in the State of Alabama.

Submission of a proposal by any person, firm, or corporation shall be prima facie evidence that he, she, or they have carefully examined the site of Work and the contract documents; that he or they have judged for, and satisfied themselves as to the conditions that will be encountered, as to the character and nature of the Work to be performed, and materials to be furnished and as to the requirements of the contract documents, and as to the contingencies. Such submission shall further be prima facie evidence that the submitting person is familiar with and shall comply with all requirements of all Federal, State and Local



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Laws and Ordinances which may directly or indirectly affect the Work, and materials or equipment used in the Work.

The Board reserves the right to reject any and all proposals, to waive formalities and technicalities in the proposals, and to delay an award of contract for a period of Thirty (30) days after the date for receiving proposals (or such other time period provided for in the Special Provisions). No proposal shall be accepted, however, without the Experience Form completed and attached.

As one of the conditions of this bid, it must be understood that knowledge and experience is extremely important. Bidder agrees that if he has not done similar work recently, or if Riviera Utilities is not absolutely convinced that the bidder has sufficient knowledge, experience, ability, equipment, etc., to properly perform the work, that it shall be sufficient grounds for the refusal of the bids.

Riviera Utilities reserves the right to refuse or reject any bid for any reason authorized by applicable law.
